New College Institute is a premier center of learning that provides access to academic degrees, credentials and professional learning experiences in high quality learning environments to prepare students for regional and statewide career opportunities and participation in collaborative, positive community change, promoting regional economic prosperity and community transformation. New College Institute provides the best of both traditional and innovative postsecondary education, continuing and professional development, community leadership, and deep-rooted partnerships to create a culture of creative thinking and problem-solving that is responsive to current and future needs. NCI does this by offering the following: A highly collaborative, technological environment and opportunities to participate from virtually anywhere with access to broadband and to technology. Our information technology at New College Institute fulfills these request by using state-of-the art technology to teach and educate our partnering colleges, universities, and our K-12 local schools. Technologies that are used to educate individuals are Polycom, Zoom, Crestron, Extron, and Steelcase. Our infrastructure is supported by Cisco routers, switches, and firewalls along with VMware software to manage our servers for Active Directory, Fileshare, Domain Controller, Anti-Virus, and VEEAM Backup. The facility is monitored by our POE (power over Ethernet) security camera system. Classes and events are scheduled using a web-based software called Officetracker. NCI will also maintain its website through a web-based hosting service with Barkley REI.

NCI will be require an investment of IT Technology overhaul to replace all outdated technology (audio visual) in one of NCI's locations. Funding options is currently being discussed with Department of General Services in connection with the purchase of the current main locations of NCI.

Technology that NCI currently has is reaching end of life. The technology must be replaced in order to align with NCI's mission to educate and also to align with Disaster Recovery. NCI also is looking to add more programs to help increase enrollment. These programs will need up to date infrastructure to accommodate these requests as needed. IT INFRASTRUCTURE TRANSITION-NCI is not on VITA network so this is not applicable. SHARED SECURITY SERVICES -Not Applicable. Not on COV network. CLOUD SOLUTIONS-Not Applicable. Not on COV network. INTERNET USEAGE-While we are not on the COV network, we don't anticipate any additional bandwidth.
