Three months later (i.e. after 31 January 2023) the 10.0.x download links will be removed; the latest 10.0.x release will be removed from the mirror system; the links to the 10.0.x documentation will be removed from tomcat.apache.org. Note that all 10.0.x releases will always be available from the archive. The final 10.0.x release was 10.0.27, released on 10 October 2022.
